Atmos Energy Works to Restore Natural Gas Service in Eaton

Eaton, Colo. – June 7, 2022 – Atmos Energy crews are working to restore natural gas service to approximately 2,500 homes and businesses in the town of Eaton and along highway 85 in Northeast Greeley due to a temporary system outage. Weld County officials and the Greeley and Eaton Fire Departments have been notified and no evacuations have been issued. Residents may see Atmos Energy trucks throughout the area working to safely turn off all natural gas meters.

“We appreciate your patience and cooperation as this process could extend through the evening hours and beyond,” said Kurtis Paradisa, Atmos Energy manager of public affairs. “We have engaged crews to ensure restoration is conducted as safely and efficiently as possible. Please be aware that we will need to access customers’ natural gas meters throughout this process.”

When natural gas service is restored, a qualified technician will perform essential services to safely relight natural gas appliances.
