



A Message for Students from Eaton Public Library

As you know, the Eaton Public Library is part of the High Plains library district. As such, we are adhering to most of the rules set forth by the district regarding restrictions on services, limiting patrons in the building, requiring masks, etc.

There are some key differences in policies and services at the Eaton Library that we want our patrons to be aware of.

Book a Librarian: Library staff will be available by appointment for individual homework help and for certain drop-in services for students. Please call 970-454-2189 or email us at epstaff@highplains.us. We will be offering this service starting Monday, August 24.

Study Spaces: The library has a limited amount of study spaces for students to work individually on school assignments. We are required to limit the number of people occupying the library at any given time, but we will make every effort to accommodate individual study needs.

Limited Time in the Library: We are encouraging everyone to use the library in a grab-and-go style, and we would prefer library visits be as quick as possible, but we understand some transactions or needs take longer. We encourage students to call or drop in so that we can help them find a good book to read or materials for their class assignments. There are fewer Internet computers, but we have some laptops which can be used by students for homework or research.

Hours: The Eaton Public Library opens at 9 am and closes at 6 pm Monday through Friday. The library opens at 10 am and closes at 4 pm on Saturday. We remain closed on Sunday.

The Eaton Public Library staff remains committed to serving the needs of our community safely during these trying times.
